Real CPR Help technology built into the electrode senses the rate and depth of chest compressions and a one-piece design ensures fast and accurate placement. CPR-D-padz are for use on adults and children over age 8 or weighing more than 55 pounds.



Pedi-padz® II Pediatric Electrodes (8900-0810-01)

Intelligent pediatric capability built into the AED Plus allows it to sense when Pedi-padz II are used and switches the AED Plus from adult to pediatric mode, modifying the device so it will provide an appropriate pediatric ECG analysis algorithm and therapy energy level. Pedi-padz II have a two-year shelf life and are for use with patients under age 8 or weighing less than 55 pounds.

Caution: Pediatric electrodes should never be used with an adult patient.
